CHAMPION TRASH RATES Increase for 2024-2025 (starting with May 2024 invoices)

For those of you who participate in the Consolidated Trash Fund, **please be aware that the trash rates will be increasing starting with the MAY 2024 invoices.** Per our 3-year contract with Champion, the rates are supposed to increase by 7.5% per year. However, since we have no outstanding collection and some surplus, starting on 6/1/2024 the new rates will be:

\$104 for 1x per week Trash Service (up from \$101) \$114 for 2x per week Trash Service (up from \$107)

There are no extra fees for credit card payments, electronic bank payments or checks. The annual payments (which are due 6/1) have no discounts, but you are welcome to make annual payments.

FRIENDLY REMINDERS ABOUT RECYCLING:

- No items set out for curbside recycling should be placed in plastic bags
- No glass bottles or jars should be set out for curbside recycling
- Glass bottles or jars (not windows mirrors, or commercial use glass) should be brought to one of the nearby purple, glass-only recycling containers. The closest purp



- cling containers. The closest purple container to our neighborhood is located at 2334 Gallows Road in Dunn Loring behind the Dunn Loring Administrative Building, on the corner of Idylwood Road and Gallows Road
- Yard debris pickup will resume on March 15th
